DAY 1 Singapore ✈ Incheon

Assemble at Singapore Changi Airport and begin your holiday with a pleasant flight to Seoul.

DAY 2 Incheon - Gimpo ✈ Jeju

- Meal on board, Lunch: Buffet,

Dinner: Korean Set Meal -

Upon arrival, meet and greet by our local representative. Proceed to **Songwol-dong Fairy Tale Village**, which is filled wonderful theme of the village by decorating classic fairy tales all around. Next, visit **Incheon's Chinatown** came into being with the opening of Incheon Port in 1883 and Incheon's designation as an extraterritoriality of the Ching Dynasty in the following year. In the past, the area held many stores trading goods imported from China, but currently most Chinese businesses in the area are restaurants. Continue to the US-originated **Premium Factory Outlets** and get good bargains on branded products such as Timberland, Nike, Adidas, Kenneth Cole, Giorgio Armani, etc.

DAY 3 Jeju

- Breakfast: Abalone Porridge, Lunch: Black Pork Bulgogi + Hallasan Fried Rice,

Dinner: Seafood Sashimi Set -

Highlight of the day is the visit to a UNESCO World Natural Heritage Site - the **Seongsan Sunrise Peak**. The Peak resembles a great ancient castle when seen from a distance. Its crater is surrounded by the volcanic ashes that were created when lava touched the cold sea more than 100,000 years ago. At its peak, be swept away by the panoramic view of the Pacific

Ocean. Next, hop into a **submarine** (subject to prevailing weather conditions) and submerge into the ocean to marvel at the interesting marine life from the glass window. Make your way to the **Tangerine Farm** where you can experience picking and tasting the tangerine (subject to seasonal conditions). Thereafter, visit the one and only of its kind in the world - the **Teddy Bear Museum**. The Museum has 2 wings: indoor and outdoor. The indoor building showcases the different types of teddy bears in collection. Witness teddy bears resembling the famous Mona Lisa, Adolf Hitler, Gandhi, etc. The outdoor museum faces the Ocean. Wander around in this garden museum and take photographs with teddy bears. Proceed to the largest **Figure Museum** in Korea, featuring Marvel character, the Avengers series, Disney's winter kingdom, all sorts of miniatures, and much more. Continue the visit to **Yongduam** (Dragon Head Rock) and **Mysterious Road** where a vehicle can drive uphill with the engine off. After dinner, enjoy "NANTA" which has achieved outstanding global acceptance. It is a nonverbal stage performance which dramatises culinary art and customary Korean percussion.

DAY 4 Jeju ✈ Gimpo - Mount Sorak National Park Region

- Hotel Breakfast, Lunch: Traditional Rice Table Set, Dinner: Seafood Steamboat -

After breakfast, visit the breathtaking **Mount Sorak National Park**, the beauty of which is accentuated by granite peaks, lush green valleys and dense forests. Ascend to the summit by **Cable Car** (subject to weather conditions). Take a peek at the impressive **Kwon Kum Seong Fortress**, which commands an excellent view of the Outer Sorak region. Next, explore the **Sokcho Central Market** for the famous Mansuk Fried Chicken (own expenses).

DAY 5 Mount Sorak National Park Region - Gangwon-Do Region

Today, a wondrous and exhilarating snow experience awaits. Next, proceed to **Dongdaemun Market**, a great shopping paradise where traditional open-air markets stand alongside modern shopping malls with fashionable clothing and accessories selling at inexpensive prices.

DAY 7 Seoul

En route, stop at the **Korean Taekuk Ginseng Gallery** and **Korean Cosmetics Showroom** where Korea-manufactured beauty products are available at affordable prices. Next, visit **N Seoul Tower**, which sits atop Namsan Mountain. Seoul Tower offers panoramic views of Seoul and the surrounding areas. Continue to the **DFS**, last but not least, have fun at **Lotte World Adventure Park (Unlimited Rides Passport Ticket**

included!) Within this mega-complex lies an international hotel, departmental store, duty-free shops, sports complex and a skating rink. Lotte World offers enjoyment of every kind with something to offer for everyone and get to meet Lotte and friends.

DAY 8 Seoul - Incheon → Singapore
